Computing

For the autumn term only (to be reviewed) Years R – 6 will be allocated a week per half term for the focused teaching of computing. This will mean that each class will get two mornings and two afternoons of computing teaching per half term.

Music

For the autumn term only (to be reviewed) Years 1 – 6 will be allocated a week per half term for the focused teaching of music. This will mean that each class will get one morning and one afternoon of music teaching per half term.

Swimming

There will be no swimming lessons in the autumn term. The hope is that these will be able to commence in the spring term.

Additional hour

For the autumn term only (to be reviewed) there will be an additional hour at the end of the school day for Years 1 to 6. This will be in the place of a formal staff meeting. Training/TeachMeet and communication will be mostly handled through MS TEAMS
