

<p>English:</p> <p>Practise forming your letters using lead ins and lead outs. Can you write your full name using your best handwriting?</p> <p>a b c d e f g h i j k l m n o p q r s t u v w x y z</p>	<p>English:</p> <p>Write a sentence about yourself remembering to use a capital letter, finger spaces and full stop at the end.</p>	<p>English:</p> <p>Write 1-2 sentences joining words using 'and'. For example:</p> <p>I love pizza and spaghetti.</p>
<p>Maths:</p> <p>Practise forming your numbers correctly. The following link will be helpful:</p> <p>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=VlQhHQAUCY</p> <p>Can you write your numbers beyond 10 or even 20?</p>	<p>Maths:</p> <p>Practise counting forwards and backwards from to 20 and beyond.</p>	<p>Maths:</p> <p>Practise adding two 1 digit numbers together e.g. 4+3=</p> <p>Can you add a 1 digit number to a 2 digit number e.g. 12+5=</p> <p>Practise subtracting two 1 digit numbers e.g. 7-2=</p> <p>Try subtracting a 1 digit number from a 2 digit number e.g. 15-4=</p>
<p>Science:</p> <p>Bring a baby photo of yourself into school, this will be used in our first Science lesson.</p> <p>Have a go at labelling the human body, you could play Simon says to help with this.</p>	<p>Science:</p> <p>Draw the basic parts of the human body and label them.</p>	<p>Science:</p> <p>Experiment with the 5 senses (Sight, touch, taste, smell, and hearing)</p> <p>How do we use these? Can you blindfold yourself and taste some different food, try to describe what you think you are eating!</p>
<p>Art:</p> <p>Draw a self portrait and find out some information about Pablo Picasso.</p>	<p>History:</p> <p>Ask your grown-ups about the toys they used to play with when they were little. Do they have any of them still? Can you bring them into school to share with the class?</p>	<p>PSHE:</p> <p>Talk about how you can show kindness at home. Can you do something to help your grown-ups at home? Perhaps you could make a kindness promise.</p>



Can you find some of these 3-D objects at home: sphere, pyramid, cube, cuboid</p> <p>Take a picture of them or bring them into school.</p>	<p>Maths:</p> <p>Play place value basketball:</p> <p>https://www.topmarks.co.uk/learning-to-count/place-value-basketball</p> <p>Identify the tens and ones for these numbers using the diene block website:</p> <p>https://mathsbot.com/manipulatives/blocks</p> <p>23, 11, 16, 35, 12, 30</p>	<p>Maths:</p> <p>Can you add a 1 digit number to a 2 digit number e.g. 12+9=</p> <p>Try subtracting a 1 digit number from a 2 digit number e.g. 19-8=</p> <p>Use a number line to help you.</p>
<p>Science:</p> <p>Find some fruit and vegetables, can you sort them into food groups- what groups can you think of?</p> <p>You could have rough, smooth, sweet, sour etc.</p> <p>You could set up your own fruit and veg stall!</p>	<p>Science:</p> <p>Draw a picture of a fish, amphibian, and reptile. Can you label the features that they have?</p>	<p>Science:</p> <p>Draw a picture of bird and insect. Can you label the features that they have?</p>
<p>Art:</p> <p>Create a collage using different materials.</p>	<p>History:</p> <p>Create a timeline for your life including any important life events.</p>	<p>PSHE:</p> <p>Draw pictures or carry out some research about the food that keeps us healthy.</p>
