

Learning Objective: To use a range of sources to locate countries.

Success Criteria:

1. To name a range of sources to locate countries.
2. To explain how to use a range of sources to locate countries.
3. To explore a range of sources to locate countries.

Starter:

Go through images on the board of the sources that you can use to locate countries. Children to match up the name to the image. Can children explain how they can use them? This is a key stage 1 target of using maps and atlases being revisited.

Main:

Go through examples of using different sources to locate countries with the children. Children to work in partners to explore a range of sources to locate the countries given to them. Go through how to use each one as a class. Go through any misconceptions

BA:

Children to have a blank map of the UK and Part of Europe. Children must use a map / atlas and google maps to locate the following countries:

England
Scotland
Wales
France
Spain
Portugal
Italy

Looking at the map children must list some physical features that they can see for example rivers / forests.

MA:

Children to have a blank map Europe. Children must use a map / atlas and google maps to locate the following countries:

England
France
Spain
Portugal
Italy
Finland
Sweden

Looking at the map children must list some physical features that they can see for example rivers / forests / cliffs / harbours etc.

HA:

Children to have a blank map Europe and Asia. Children must use a map / atlas and google maps to locate the following countries:

Portugal
Italy
Finland
Sweden
China
India
Vietnam

Looking at the map children must list some physical features that they can see for example rivers / forests / cliffs / harbours etc.

Plenary:

Children to identify countries on blank map on the board and explain some key features that they have found.
